Tanabata 七夕

Tanabata, Star Festival is held on July 7 in most parts of Japan or August 7 in some areas. Based on a Chinese folk legend in which two stars - Altair (Cowherd) and Vega (Weaver) - love each other but only allowed to cross the Milky Way to meet once a year on this day. Wishes are written on long colored strips of paper and hung from a bamboo branch with other decorations.

Ukai 鵜飼

Cormorant fishing, an ancient method of catching Ayu (sweetfish or trout-like fish), handling cormorants. This usually takes place at night under the blazing torches fastened to the prows of fishing boats from May until October.

(2) <i>Ato-Matsuri</i> in which <i>Yama-hoko-Junko</i> (a procession of another 11 floats) and <i>Hanagasa-Junko</i> (a long colorful pageant) consists of many dancing groups, children and <i>Geisha</i> , all in traditional costumes. Tanabata, Star Festival is held on July 7 in most parts of Japan or August 7 in some areas. Based on a Chinese folk legend in which two starts - Altair (Cowherd) and Vega (Weaver) - love each other but only allowed to cross the Milky Way to meet once a year on this day. Wishes are written on long colored strips of paper and hung from a bamboo branch with other decorations.
