People pay homage to shrines and temples, and visit friends and relatives to exchange greetings. There are also customs such as eating Osechiryori - New Year's special dishes, and giving children Otoshidama - New Year's money gift. On New Year's Day, Nengajo - New Year greeting cards, arrive in the mail

### Shogatsu 正月

Shogatsu is the biggest annual event in Japan. The streets are adorned with New Year's decorations of pine and plum branches, bamboo stalks and ropes with paper festoons. People pay homage to shrines and temples, and visit friends and relatives to exchange greetings. There are also customs such as eating *Osechi-ryori* - New Year's special dishes, and giving children *Otoshidama* - New Year's money gift. On New Year's Day, *Nengajo* - New Year greeting cards, arrive in the mail.
